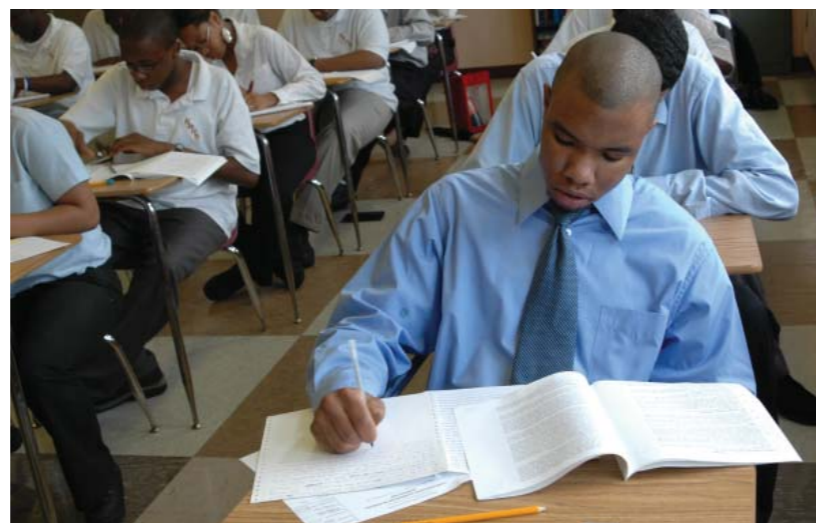

We accept both Catholic and non-Catholic students. Nazareth's curriculum has been nationally recognized for its excellence in meeting the needs of all of our students. We have an almost 100% graduation rate and over 95% of our graduates attend four year colleges – most are accepted at their first choice college.

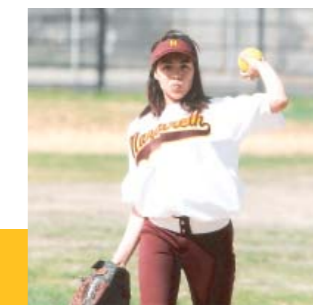
